

Requirements for the design of theses

The theses of the report are a summary of the article and the oral report. The main reduction in volume is achieved due to the lack of a sufficient description of the methods used and their application, but only the fact of their use is mentioned.

The main text of the theses includes:

- a brief description of the relevance of the issue under study and the field as a whole;
- setting goals and individual tasks, the solution of which allows you to achieve the goal;
- listing of the materials and methods used and their purpose;
- interpretation of the result;
- conclusions;
- recommendations;

The structure of the theses is as follows:

- headline information;
- main text of the theses;
- list of references.

Design requirements:

- Volume – no more than 2 pages;
- Font – Times New Roman, 12 pt;
- Line spacing – 1.0;
- The indentation of the new paragraph is 1.25 cm;
- Page orientation – portrait;
- Margins – 2.5 cm on all sides.

(The numbering is done as the text is quoted, not in alphabetical order. The reference number must be placed in square brackets at the end of the sentence before the dot. The link to the scientific article should contain the following information: authors, year, title of the article, title of the journal, volume/issue, first and last pages of the article. References to the book should include only the year of publication and the number of pages. A digital object identifier (DOI) must be inserted at the end of each source.)

1. Authors. (Year of issue). Title of the article. *Title of the journal*, Volume (number of issue), first page of the article – the last page of the article. DOI
