Regulation of Young Scientists Council of Noncommercial Joint Stock Company «National Center for Children's Rehabilitation»

1. General regulation

1. These Regulations on Young Scientists Council (hereinafter — Council, YSC) Noncommercial Joint Stock Company «National Center for Children's Rehabilitation» (hereinafter —Company, Center, NJSC «NCCR») was designed to attract young scientists to solve issues of the development of science and technology, to promote and develop creative scientific activity, and to participate in the country's research and innovation activities.

2. Council - is an advisory and consultative structure and formed from employees of various departments of the Center.

3. Young scientists are defined as researchers, master's students, residents, doctoral students, lecturers and center staff involved in scientific activities who are under 35-40 years of age..

4. Young Scientists Council is a public structure under the NJSC «NCCR»

5. The activities of the Council are coordinated by the Chairman of the Council, who is appointed by the Chairman of the Board of the NJSC «NCCR».

2. Main tasks of Young Scientists Council of NJSC «NCCR»

6. Promoting the professional growth of young scientists of the Center and the active participation of young scientists in fundamental and applied scientific researches.

7. Acting as a representative body and protecting the rights on the

scientific activities of young people in the academic council and management of the organization, expressing the opinions of young scientists on various aspects of professional activity and social and living conditions.

8. Joining efforts of young scientists to solve the actual scientific problems and priority scientific tasks.

9. Activization of scientific research work by young scientists through a system of specially designed measures.

10. Improving the forms of participation of young scientists in research projects, scientific grants, competitions, programs, and trainings.

11. Establishing and expanding a network of contacts with councils of young scientists from other scientific organizations of higher education institutions.

3. Forms of activity of the Council of Young Scientists

12. Organization of conferences, seminars, and meetings of young scientists, scientific schools, and lecture series by leading scientists; promotion and financial support for the participation of young scientists in national and international conferences, seminars, symposiums, and internships.

13. Organization of information support for young scientists about funds, grants, conferences, schools, competitions, and other events in the Republic of Kazakhstan, neighboring countries, and countries of the Far Abroad, as well as about measures of state support for young scientific personnel in the Republic of Kazakhstan.

14. Collecting and systematizing of information about domestic and foreign funds and programs that provide grant support to young scientists.

15. Providing methodological, organizational, and material support for the publication of scientific articles by young scientists in highly rated peer-reviewed journals included in the Scopus, Web of Science, and other databases.

16. Organization of participation in joint research projects of young scientists from Kazakhstan, foreign higher education institutions, and research centers.

4. Powers of the Council of Young Scientists

17. In order to perform its main functions, the Council shall have the right to:
1) prepare proposals on all issues related to the work of the Council, on

improving the material and technical support for the scientific activities of young scientists;

2) participate in the preparation and review of scientific documents and regulatory acts.

3) make proposals to support and encourage individual young scientists for their achievements;

4) present young scientists as candidates for participation in scientific conferences, competitions, projects, seminars, symposiums, etc.;

5. Organizational principles of the Young Scientists Council

18. The Council consists of young scientists from the Company who participate on a voluntary basis. The Chairman organizes the Council's activities and represents the interests of the Center's young scientists.

19. The Chairman of the Council may be elected from among the employees of the Society, up to 40 years of age at the time of election, for a term of up to three years by secret or open ballot by a simple majority of the registered members of young scientists. The meeting shall be considered quorate if more than half of the registered members of young scientists are present at the meeting.

20. The Chairman of the Council participates in meetings of the Scientific Council of the Center.

21. The Council carries out its work based on an annual work plan. According to the results of the year's work, the CYS prepares a report and presents it at the general meeting of the Council, the Scientific Council of the organization.
