The text of review articles has an introduction, as well as the main part, structured into subsections with titles and conclusions.

Introduction

Purpose of the study

The essence and purpose of the study should be clearly defined. It is necessary to justify and indicate the specific goals of the article.

Title of the subsection

The main part of review article can have several subsections with titles

Conclusions

Conclusions should be linked to the whole article and formalized as a single paragraph. Conclusions should not contain unqualified statements.

Conflict of interests

The authors must declare the presence/absence of a conflict of interest.

List of references (The total number of used literature must be at least 20 sources)

1. Authors. (Year of issue). Title of the article. *Title of the journal*, Volume (number of issue), first page of the article – the last page of the article. DOI

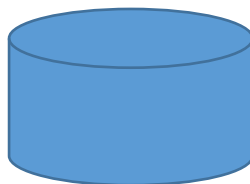


Figure 1. Title of the figure
