## **Rights and duties of trainees**

### **Trainees have rights to:**

- 1) receive quality education in accordance with educational programs of additional education;
- 2) respect for human dignity, protection from all forms of physical and mental violence, personal insults, protection of life and health;
- 3) free expression of one's own views and beliefs;
- 4) introduction with the certificate of institutional accreditation in the accreditation bodies entered in the register of recognized accreditation bodies, with educational documentation, other documents regulating the organization and implementation of educational activities in the Company;
- 5) free use of textbooks, teaching aids, teaching aids, library and information resources, educational base of the Company;
- 6) appeal to the commission for the settlement of disputes between participants in educational relations;
- 7) demand from the Executor timely provision of the Services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement for the paid provision of educational services.

### **Trainees required to:**

- 1) conscientiously master the educational program, fulfill the educational program, including attending the training sessions provided for by the educational program, independently prepare for them, perform tasks given by teachers within the framework of the educational program;
- 2) comply with the requirements of the Charter, these Rules and other local regulations of the Company on the organization and implementation of educational activities;
- 3) take care of preserving and strengthening their health, strive for moral, spiritual and physical development and self-improvement;
- 4) immediately inform the educator responsible for the implementation of the event about each accident that occurred to them or witnesses of which they became;
- 5) respect the honor and dignity of other trainees and employees of the Company, not create obstacles for other trainees to receive education;
- 6) take care of the Company's property;
- 7) observe the uniform established in the Company;
- 8) strictly comply with the requirements of the rules of labor protection, fire safety, industrial sanitation and hygiene;
- 9) attend training courses;
- 10) observe the Company's work schedule;

11) timely pay for the Services in accordance with Section 2 of the Agreement of paid provision of educational services;

12) keep confidential information about patients obtained during training and not disclose it in public places and in the presence of persons unrelated to the patient, except for the need to notify medical personnel about the patient's condition, as well as persons marked by the patient in the «Voluntary informed consent of the patient for examination and treatment in the NJSC «NCCR».

**Trainees are prohibited:**

1) to bring, transfer, use in the Company and on its territory weapons, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, toxic and narcotic substances and other objects and substances that can harm the health of participants in the educational process and (or) demoralize the educational process;

2) bring, transfer and use any objects and substances that can lead to explosions, fires and poisoning;

3) have a scruffy and defiant appearance;

4) use physical force against other trainees, employees of the Company and other persons;

For non-fulfillment or violation of the Charter of the Company, these Rules and other local regulations on the organization and implementation of educational activities, trainees are responsible in accordance with these Rules.

**Protection of the rights of trainees**

**In order to protect their rights, trainees have the right to:**

1) send appeals to the Company's management bodies about violation and (or) infringement by its employees of the rights, freedoms and social guarantees of trainees;

2) apply to the commission for the settlement of disputes between participants in educational relations;

3) use other methods not prohibited by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan to protect their rights and legitimate interests.
